Getting There

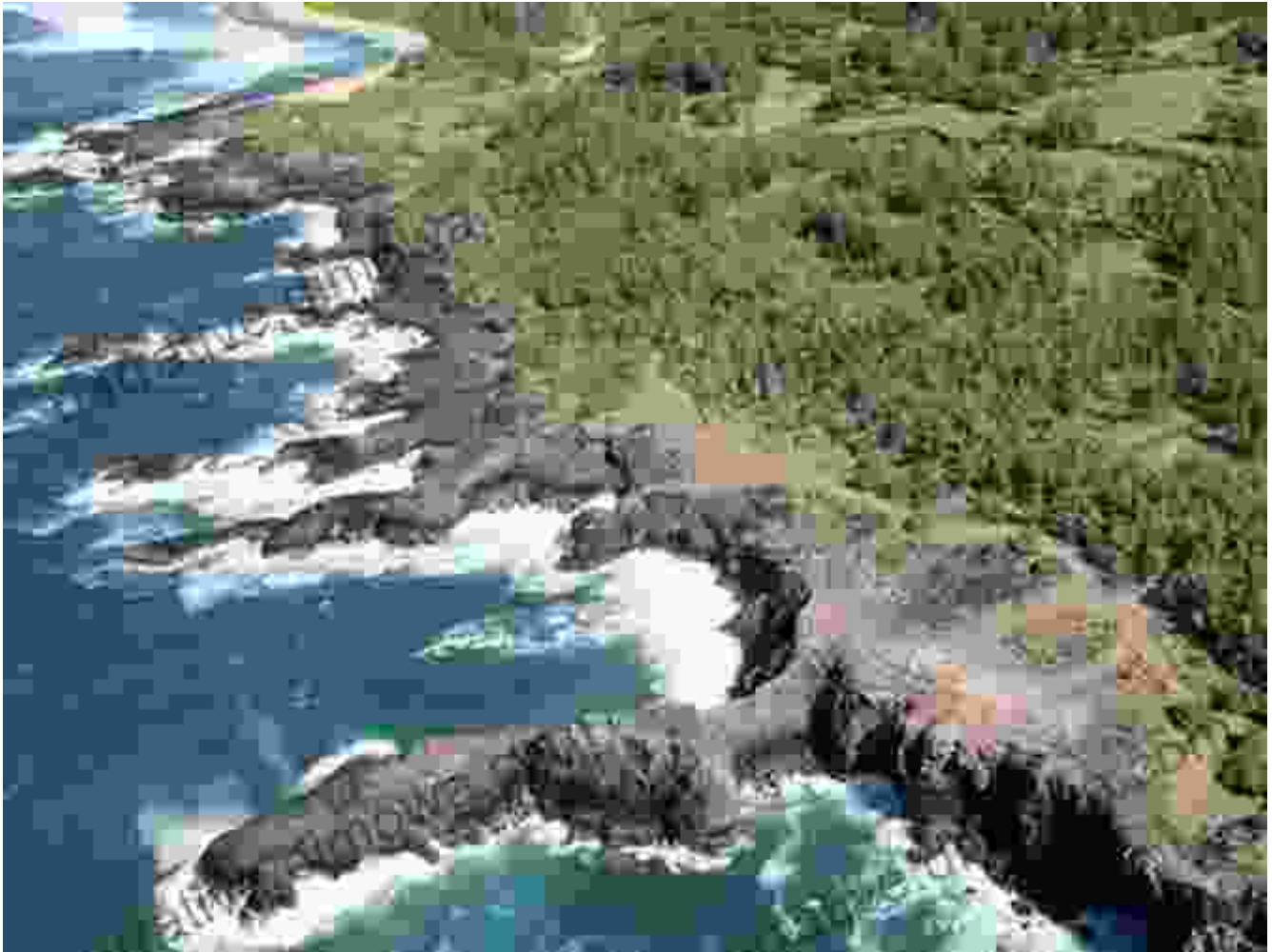
The south coast of Mauritius is easily accessible by car or taxi. The drive from the capital city of Port Louis takes about 1 hour.

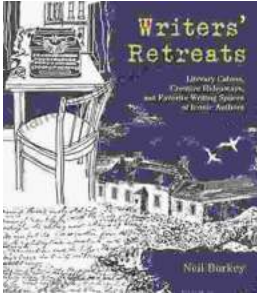


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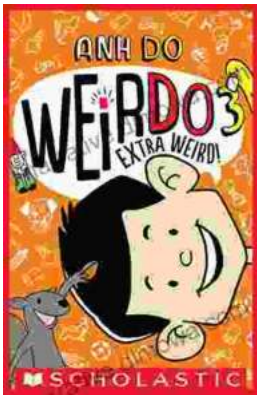
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
