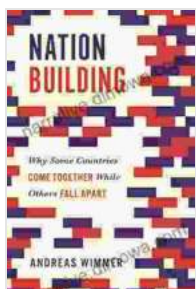

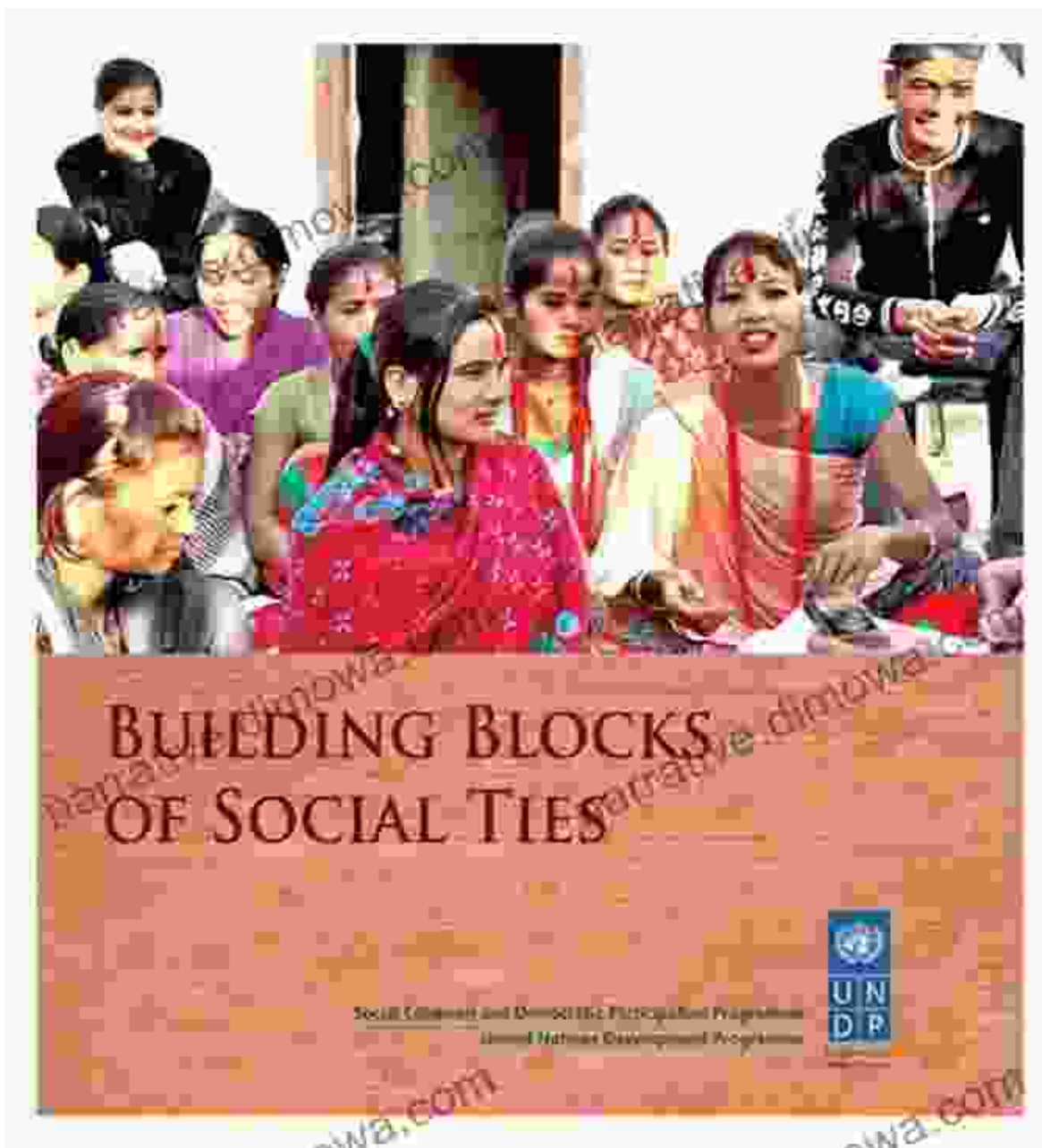

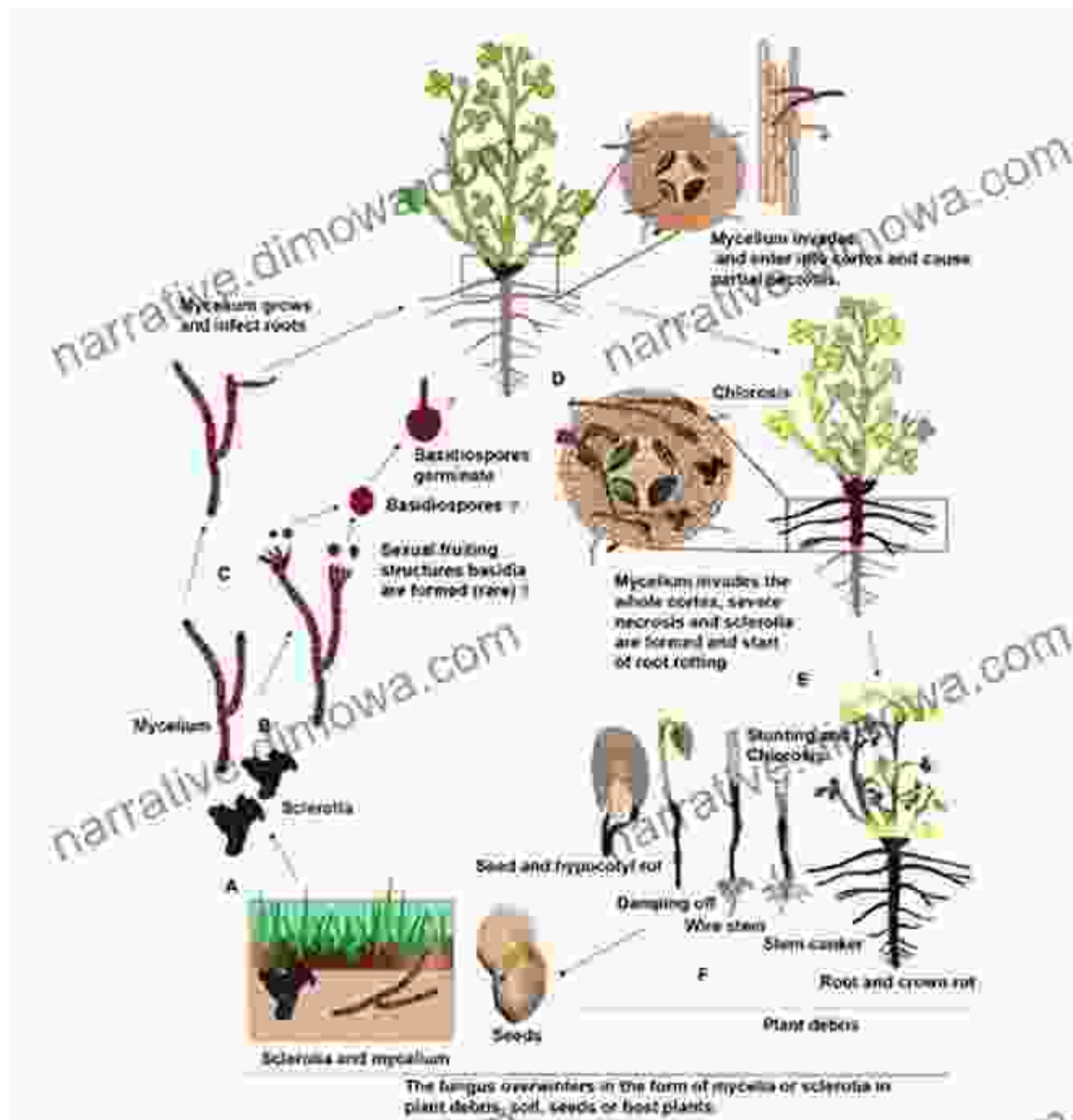

### Abstract

Ideas and claims about children's development (e.g., concerning attachment relationships) that have found broad acceptance in the academic community have impacted the development of policy in governmental and international organizations. 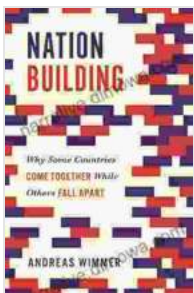
- Promoting inclusive policies that foster a sense of belonging among all citizens, regardless of their background.

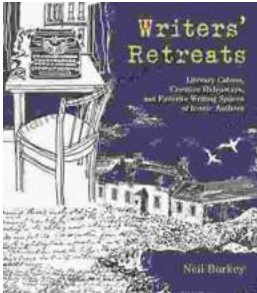

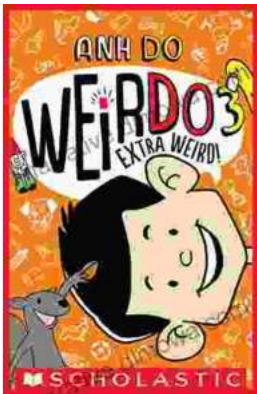
